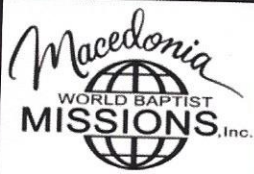

As you all know, last year the government of Kenya approved our school Lifeway Christian Academy to offer junior secondary school. This is a great opportunity for you and us to reach out to more people and spread the gospel. As of now, we have 22 students in junior secondary school, and we thank our heavenly Father for that. However, this has come with a

lot of requirements to sustain and raise the kids to be schooled to reach their uttermost potential academically.

As of the month of January and February we managed to purchase 3600 building blocks for the construction of the new learning facilities. Thank you so much for the prayers and support. We have started working on the next phase which includes the following requirements:

1. A dozen tons of sand costing \$550.
2. Gravel 10 tones costing \$450.
3. Iron sheets costing \$2500.
4. 400 pieces of wood frames costing \$1000.
5. 200 bags of cement costing \$1600.
6. Labor cost amounting to \$1000.
7. The cost of windows amount to \$1000.



We appreciate the contributions for nails and wall bars. As a directive from the government, it requires us to complete this project as soon as possible. We humbly request for your support.
