Pam joined me in Baguio City to preach for Lighthouse Bible Baptist Church and help them on their PWD Sunday. Praise the Lord for 191 professions of faith.

New PWD NATIONAL Ministry!

Since November last year, the Lord has opened up an opportunity where we can help and reach Persons-With-Disability nationwide. A former congresswoman who is a very close friend has asked me to help her in a foundation aimed in providing mobility devices to PWDs in the country. With this, I launched a program named after the foundation but with the purpose of bringing PWDs to the Lord. Dubbed as #AKAYniSOLsaPanginoon, we have given more than 10,000 assistive devices particularly to several pastors whose immediate family members cannot afford to buy this devices. But also a joy to see many PWDs come to know the Lord. I always use the story of the blind man that came to Jesus in the book of Mark where He said to him, "Go thy way thy faith has made thee whole." I tell them if they put their trust in Jesus alone admitting they are sinners they will be made whole both spiritually and literally on resurrection morning. To this I have watched man of them weep and receive our Savior.

As I turn 50 years old this October and as we celebrate our 25th Wedding Anniversary on January 2024, we pray that the Lord will continue to enable us physically, financially and most importantly spiritually to continue to serve and see people saved, lives changed, families built, people serving faithfully, and the Gospel preached in many other places.

We still pray Lord willing, to be back there and personally report to you how God is continually using you to encourage and sustain us by your prayers and support.

CHBC CHURCH MINISTRY UPDATES!

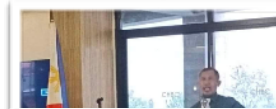


We just came from our Church Adult and Youth Camp held in Isabela province 14 hours up north from

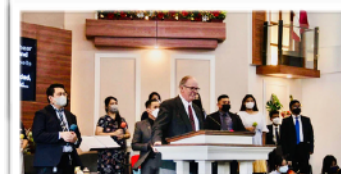

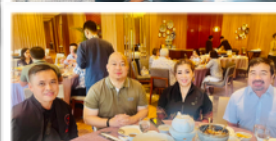
