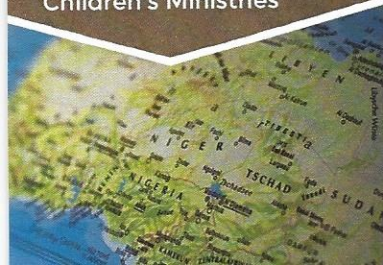

Greetings in the name of the Lord,

April 2023

We are back in Ghana now! The whole family is trying to get used to the weather here. It was very hot when we landed, and now we are entering into the rainy season. Deborah and the boys quickly got set up again for homeschooling, and they have been at it. Joseph is glad to get back to see his friend Micah Kenney, and Josh and Jeremiah have their Ghanaian friends. There was a lot to clean up after being gone for almost 11 months, but everyone got to it, and we are now settled in.

The church is still moving slowly. As our teens are entering into their late teens there are many challenges to try to get them focused on the things of God and not the temporal things only. At the age of 16 and 17 here, many will stop school after Junior High and start to work. Others will go to Senior High where they will major in things that don't have a future because of limited job availabilities and bad counsel from family and friends. We are fighting a battle to keep them from the music and sexual temptations that are all around us.

The church land has hit another snag. It will be a miracle if we can get our paperwork done legally here now. There are some problems with it being hung up in the court system because of some corrupt people trying to take the land. I don't know what to do other than just pray that God will show the way.

We were able to renew our rent on our church store front for another 2 years. Here we have to rent for two years at a time and pay in advance.

We have been preaching on the radio for years here in Ghana as when I was in Mali. We chose a non-Christian station to reach the unreached or unchurched. Pray for us as we are on two stations one time a week each. These stations allow us to preach the gospel in villages and towns we will never get to. Pray as we try to get a weeklong radio revival on one of the stations leading up to Easter.

Pray as we try to get the gospel out in our area that God would work on the hearts of our people and the people in the villages around ours. We have been witnessing in neighboring villages with the desire to see a Bible study in a nearby village.

When we returned back to Ghana, we had another missionary come by our church, and he was astonished at the church above us in the same building. He said, "That is just flesh." I told him that is what we fight all the time here! We fight carnal fleshly worship of a god that isn't holy and can't save. Pray for us that we can get them to the true and holy God of the Bible.
