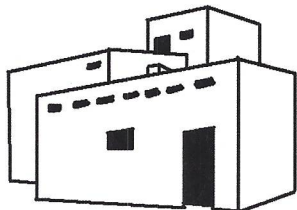

I then proceeded to tell him that it's the time of the year that we celebrate the fact that Jesus Christ, the beloved Son of God died on the cross for our sins, was buried, and arose from the grave on the third day! As I shared the gospel with him, Brad, smiled and said, "Rodney, I've never heard of that." Wow! This Native American kid had never heard the gospel. He didn't know who Jesus Christ is. I wasn't able to win him to Christ right then and there; but he did accept a tract and talked about coming to visit our church in Bernalillo. It's amazing that in our day and age that we can still find people who have never heard the Gospel.

During this quarter we have also taken on three new missionaries, bringing our total now to eight.
