Thank the Lord, the clouds are starting to bring relief with a bit of rain. By the time you receive this letter, the time will have passed for the yearly music festival. Please help us pray that we see spiritual blessings despite the worldly influence that usually brings. The crime rate and the economy continue to bring bad news.

My Latest Surgery

I had the opportunity to preach at another church before my surgery and Martha taught a ladies' group. Thank the Lord, everything went well with the surgery. I will have to have a third surgery. They only operated on the right side of my neck. I have an appointment on the 24th. of May to plan the operation on the left side. I had two nerves cut (C2 and C3) which has resulted in a permanent numbness on the right side, face, and shoulder. I have a bit of stiffness raising my right arm and am learning to shave as the swelling continues to slowly go down.

With The Church

Brother Simeon continued to help me through my surgery and our time away while I began my recovery. It was a blessing to have Bro. Reyna help. Several were evangelized and saved who came to the Church. We thank the Lord for the help we have received from Brother Joel. We have a group of 19 young people and we have seen up to 10 professions of faith each week going out to win souls. The first week I was away, Brother Julio Cesar died after a few years battling with stomach cancer. Brother Joel was able to preach his funeral and be a great blessing to Brother José and his family. He also helped with another situation when a young man who had made a profession of faith lost his mother. We knew that the Lord could call her home at any time.

Deaths And Murder

Brother Silvio, who attends here, asked for prayers for his son and his son's friend who have been missing since February 25 in southwest GA. They still have not been found. One of the hardest things to face since I've been here is March 21, Bro. Albert Mendoza was found murdered by blows to the face. His body was found on the plot of land he farmed at the house where he lived by the river. He was the first man that I lead to the Lord here in Valledupar. He was a leader of the Kankuamo indigenous tribe. He was a great help to us when we got here and throughout the time we knew him. He will be greatly missed. Please help us pray for his family and the Church.

The Constant Need For Prayer

We know that the Lord is our only refuge. Please continue to pray for our family, for our health, for our safety, and for our spiritual well-being. We can always tell when someone is praying because prayer makes a difference. Your faithful prayers and offerings are the means the Lord uses to keep us here and enable us to continue to minister.
