Since coming back last fall, we have been using Basecamp for many different outings. It is exciting to see our dream becoming a reality. In December, we had a "Who Will Go" Conference planned. Unfortunately, those who were supposed to come from America to preach didn't make it, but that didn't hinder us from having the conference. We quickly handed out the preaching assignments and hurried to get the first set of dorms as close to finished as we could. What a blessing to have over 150 people present to challenge them to take the Gospel to the world. We divided the youth into four different teams and had them compete against each other. A different puzzle piece was awarded to the winning team of each competition. In the end, all of the teams had to come together and combine their pieces to complete a puzzle. Sometimes we as Christians think we are competing against each other when actually, we have a common goal and serve the same Master.

We moved our Bible college to Basecamp in January. This has made our time training the men and women that come more productive. Our church and other churches have had church outings there over the past few months. We had a pastor's conference in February with around 50 pastors or those training to be pastors present. Our churches joined together to have a women's conference on the property with around 120 in attendance.

Even though we have made great progress in building Basecamp (thanks to your prayers and those who have given financially), we never got to finish phase one. We hope to complete that phase and the rest of what is needed so we can have youth camp on the land in August. With three important buildings left to build (girl's dorm, sanctuary, cafeteria/conference room), taxes to pay, and recreational areas (basketball court, soccer field, etc.) \$200,000 should finish out what we need before camp.


