We have a new person attending church now. He is Jewish and was saved several years ago. He gives a very clear testimony of his salvation. Our attendance is starting to pick up. Some of our farmers are back in town now that spring planting is going on. A lot of them leave for the winter. One of our men, the song leader, has been learning to play the piano. We had the Lords Supper a couple of weeks ago, and he surprised us all by playing the piano during that time. He is not quite good enough to play all the time, but I am excited to see someone putting some effort into it. We are still in need of a piano player and someone to work with the youth. A few years ago, right before Covid, I met with the men to discuss looking for someone to hire that could do this. We were going to go ahead with looking for someone and then Covid changed everything. At that time, we had enough money coming in to do that, but our attendance dropped, and of course, the tithes and offerings went with it. But things are getting some better now.

Our next event we have planned is the 4th of July parade that we enter a float in. It gives us a great opportunity to reach the community. We don't have to go to them; they all come to town to watch the parade, and we get to give out tracts and church literature and advertise any event we have planned. All in about 30 minutes. One year we even won a \$300 prize for having the best float in the parade. We didn't even know there was a contest going on. We aren't in it for the prize, but please do pray for us as we do this that we can reach someone for Christ.

My wife had cataracts removed in both of her eyes and has recovered, but one eye is still not cleared up yet. We would appreciate your prayers for that as well.

We installed the chair lift in the church, and that has been a blessing. We should get the handicapped bathroom built this summer. We don't really have any handicapped people in the church, but we will be compliant with the codes, and we really need a bathroom upstairs anyway. This will kill two birds with one stone.

I want to thank all of you for your support and prayers. We hope to get down south this fall, and maybe we can come for a visit to some of you. It will have to be between fall and winter. Too much to do here when the weather is good, and when the weather turns bad, someone has to be here to do battle with winter.
