Dear Saints and Faithful Brethren in Christ,

It is a blessing to be in touch again by means of our Prayer Letter. Thanks for keeping your hearts towards us and the eternal destiny of souls here in Valledupar. As the Atlantic hurricane season starts up, it rains more frequently as winds and moisture take aim headed mostly northwest through the Caribbean and Gulf regions. It has been what I call "sticky hot." Grass is growing and we don't have to water lawns or trees. Some of the problems we have are that the water and the electricity go off.

Concerning My Health

Thank the Lord, although it has been a long process, I have the good news that all has gone well with my neck surgeries. I have received three major surgeries in the last six months and have one more treatment to go in just a few days with iodine to remove the remnants that are microscopic. In about six months, we will be planning surgery for a tumor under my right ear that needs to be removed.

My right arm is feeling a bit more limber since the surgery, and I am slowly learning how to live with the symptoms of Parkinson's. Please pray that I get to exercise my muscles in the correct ways and avoid losing muscle tone.

Saying Goodbye to Brother Joel

Brother Joel was a great blessing to our family and to the Church. He was faithful in evangelizing. He had to return to Mexico. We are very grateful for the help he gave us during the time that Brother Simeon has taken over in my absence. Although the people of Valledupar seem hard-hearted, there is also a lot of false doctrine here.

We have had a great emphasis on missions and evangelizing, we still lack workers. We ask for your prayers for the Lord to send workers and provide a person that He has called to receive the Church.

Bro. Silvio's Son

Even though it took a long time to receive the results from the DNA testing, they were able to identify the remains of Bro. Silvio's son that were found on a farm in southwest GA. Please continue to pray for this situation and for the families affected. Also, that those responsible for the murders of the two in GA and of Bro. Albert here in Valledupar would be brought to justice and the families helped by the Lord as they suffer this.
