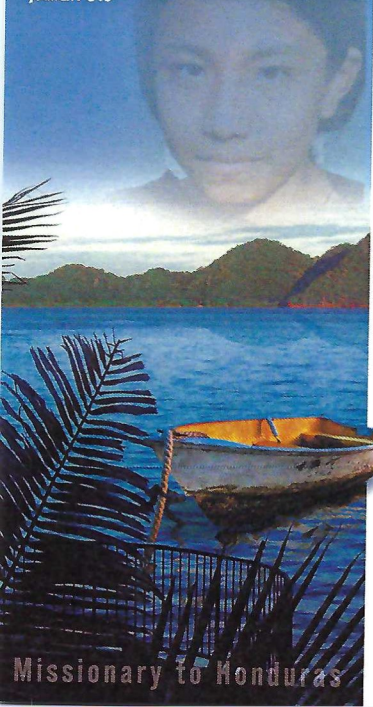

On July 7th, a group of men from the church came and helped me move. They had everything moved into the new house before 10 AM that day! Two ladies from the church helped me clean the floors of the old house and then came to the new house and helped me clean and set it up. Our church is filled with men and women who have a servant's heart and are ready to help out in any way they can.

July 6th - July 8th, our youth were blessed to be able to take part in a youth conference at another church. It was great to hear their testimonies of how the messages spoke to their hearts.

On the 22nd, we went into a community called El Olivar and had a Bible Club for the children there. Bible Clubs are probably my favorite part of the ministry. Just the thought that a new group of children (some for the very first time) are hearing about Jesus makes my heart soar to new heights. Many of them start coming to church as a result of the clubs and eventually accept Jesus as their Savior. And that is what it's all about!

Thanks to each of you who make it possible for me to be here and be able to take part in the wonderful ministry the Lord has here in Santa Rita, Yoro Honduras. I can't imagine life any other way.

Please continue to pray for the ministry here, especially for teachers in the school. The last I heard, we have more than doubled our enrollment from last year. God is good!
