Dear Supporters and Prayer Partners,

Thank you so very much for your willingness to keep me in your prayers! These past two months have been amazing. I've had the opportunity to be in some great places and meet some great people! The Lord has continued to bless me with meetings. I've driven around 5,000 miles and been in a couple of different states. I have already begun to book meetings for the year 2024! Please pray that God will continue to send in both the meetings and the support. In my last prayer letter, I mentioned that I was at 30% of my support, but as this letter goes out, I am now close to 40%! Praise the Lord for His faithfulness!

I recently had a week that I wasn't scheduled to be anywhere for a meeting, which enabled me to spend a couple of days in the state of New Hampshire. The purpose of this trip was to talk with some people there and tell them about the Gospel. I specifically focused on the two towns of Milford and Peterborough. Milford is a town of a little over 15,000 souls. Peterborough has about 6,500 souls and no Bible preaching Baptist church. I ask that you please put these two towns on your prayer list. I would love to see God send more laborers to New England to help shine the Gospel light in these towns and many more like them.

I also ask that you pray for two specific people. The first one is a man named Sam. He moved to New Hampshire from California a couple of years ago himself and inquired as to why I am moving there as well. This gave me the opportunity to open up a conversation about starting a church. I shared the Gospel with him, and he told me that he's holding on to "multiple gods." We then talked about Jesus and the Gospel during the flight from Dallas to Boston. Please pray that he will be saved!

The second one is a man named Jose. He is the song leader for the Unitarian Universalist church in Milford, New Hampshire. He is living a life of sin and is trusting in "good works" to get him into Heaven. It is very sad to see that one of the biggest tools Satan uses is religion! This causes people to believe the things they do aren't all that bad because they "go to church" or "try and live a good life." The sad fact is that's not enough to get anyone into Heaven. Please help me pray for not only Sam and Jose but many more just like them, not only in New Hampshire but all across the world.
