

I hope this letter finds each of you closer in communion with God and Christ Jesus. May God's peace and hope keep you in the present evil world. I want to thank each of you for your prayers and giving. This is a difficult time for many, and our world is uncertain. As crazy as the world is, remember we are the ones with the help that they need.

Deborah and the boys are doing fine. Deborah has had a few health things but nothing major. All the boys are growing taller and getting older which is both wonderful and sad at the same time. Joseph is taller than me with Joshua closing in. Jeremiah might stay short with his dad.

The last few months have been full, and we are trying to move forward here. The Lord has blessed, and I was able to write a basic Bible study on the book of Romans and get it published here in a booklet form. It wasn't very expensive; so we are able to produce them and get them out for about a dollar a piece into the hands of people that we are trying to reach out to. This was a long process, but I would love to be able to get different studies out and printed to give to our people. Many around me claim to be Christians but don't even understand salvation.

The radio programs are going well. I preach a message that goes out on one radio station every Wednesday morning at 5:30am and another that goes out every Friday night at 9pm. Friday night, I preach live, but Wednesday morning has to have a translator and be recorded as the radio audience doesn't speak English as much as the Friday night one. Several we have witnessed to have told me they have heard me preach on the radio.

We are going door to door every Saturday morning with Jeremy Kenney. This has helped us to go not only in our village but also in several surrounding villages to get out the gospel. We have had many good encounters, but when we are out, we encounter Muslims, Catholics, JW's and every denomination plus some animist. Pray that God would draw the hearts of our people. It is very difficult here because many don't understand the gospel even after you explain it several times. The Devil has done much to confuse our people.

The church Kansaworado Independent Baptist Church is now over 8 years old. We have had a ton of challenges because it is hard for us to keep adults in an entertainment driven society. Much like the US everyone wants to only feel good and are not looking for edification nor truth. I told one missionary here "It is like having a product with no market." Every church around me only entertains the people, and most promise things that God has never promised and follow things that are against the Bible. Our church people are being pulled by family, friends, and society to seek only wealth and sexual fulfillment, with God being a footnote. Please pray for our church people! I am doing everything I know how with the help of Jeremy Kenney to reach out to our area and surrounding areas. Our village of Kansaworado or Kansa for short is growing, but most are not seeking the true God. Churches are popping up everywhere without truth or the gospel. It is very sad. Pray for us as we want to have a VBS in December. Our summer breaks were lost because we are still trying to catch up from the Covid lockdowns.

Pray for Ghana that the Gospel would go forward and that repentance and faith would be preached here. Pray that Jake, Cash, Ken, Frank, Moses, Eman, and many others that Deborah and I are witnessing to would be saved.
