The Need For A Permanent Place

Unemployment continues to plague Valledupar. Those who have jobs face opposition to attending Church and some have to work outside the city. Political parties rented many of the buildings in the area and made it difficult to locate a suitable location. The Church in Valledupar could offer more to a younger couple called to work here if they had their own building.

We are praying that the Lord will put it in your hearts to help us. The small amount of money the Church has saved is worth less every day due to inflation. You can indicate that the offerings are designated to the Building Fund 05 account.

The Need For The Church To Grow

Due to the urgent situation of having to relocate the Church, we were not able to have a missions emphasis at this time of year. We have been putting stickers on the tracts we have. We continue to emphasize missions and continue to evangelize as we work to rebuild things. In many ways we are starting over. Please pray that the Lord will send workers and the help we need. We ask that you pray that hardened hearts may be broken and that we may see lasting fruit in the labor for souls.

We thank the Lord that Martha's nephew (Esteban) was here to help us. He filled lots of spaces and worked very hard to help us. He and his family are now back in Tunja. Please pray that he and his family follow the will of the Lord.
