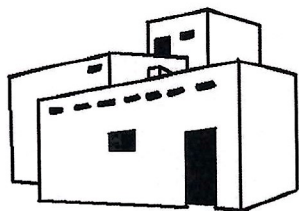

We have seen several folks saved over the past couple months. Brother Al Sena and I went out in a new area in town to do some door knocking. We placed flyers in the doors and gates of many homes in the area, inviting them to our services. In one driveway, we stopped to talk to three people: two from Mexico and one from Venezuela. He was quite possibly the easiest person to lead to Christ that I've ever met. He sat crying in my office thanking me for telling him how to be saved. When he walked out the door to head home, he turned back, smiling and said, "Preacher, thank you for telling me about Jesus!"
