As our last prayer letter of 2023, we want to say thank you for your continued prayers and support. You have enabled us to reach many for Christ this past year.

I'm sure that you've heard of or saw the famous Christmas movie, *It's a Wonderful Life*? It's a fictitious story about a man who wished he'd never been born. His wish was granted and he was allowed to see a messed up world where he didn't exist. However, I submit to you a more serious scenario. What if you and I had not heard the gospel? What if we had no desire to win the lost? Satan would love to convince you and me that what we do makes no difference, but he cannot refute the fact that many have come to Christ because of our teamwork together. We have received salvation letters from Africa, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Canary Islands Spain, Chile, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, England, Guyana, Haiti, Jamaica, Japan, Mexico, Moldova, Puerto Rico, Romania, France, Ukraine and more. In the United States, we have received letters from almost every state as well as prison ministries and homeless shelters. We have shipped out the 150,000 English tracts for Berean Armed Forces Ministry. Patrick Hayes, who heads up this ministry shared that on Veterans Day, 15,300 Veterans received a Gospel packet.
