We have been met with a few challenges this month as well. We ministered in the Brookdale Memory Care center amidst widespread sickness, yet the 3 of us who hold the services there have remained well. We strive to care for the flock in these different situations and desire your prayers for us as we seek to shepherd those entrusted to our care. We yet experience negative reactions as we go door to door, but this is to be expected and is minimal. Outreach continues presently in Redmond and Tumalo, and wherever the day may take us as we live our lives here in central Oregon. We are working on building a relationship with three men at this current time and have met for Bible studies with one, although many hindrances have prevented them all this month.
