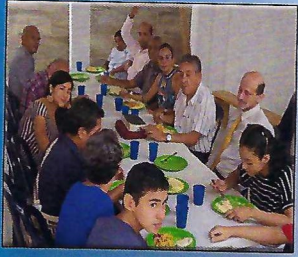

Even with changing buildings and moving the Lord is blessing. A lady has come to know the Lord that we have been in contact with for a long time. She asks prayer for her son who is in trouble. Please pray for her to be faithful in trusting the Lord and follow the Lord in baptism. A lady from Venezuela has been attending several Sundays and appears to show interest in the Church.

Trusting The Lord For Opportunities

A man who lives with his family in Aruba visited on Sunday and his dad died the very next day. We met his sister who also lives in Aruba and attends the same Church there. He, his wife, children, and sister are Baptists. I was asked to preach at the funeral. He and his sister plan to be with us in the short time before they go back. Please pray that we can follow up on the lost in that family that live in Valledupar.

He was here doing that a few years ago and helped me evangelize. Also, around the mid part of February, we plan to have a Pastor from Texas with us, to evangelize and speak on the family. We also thank the Lord; Martha was able to have some important medical tests done that turned out well. In mid-January, I will be having a checkup about the surgeries on my neck and follow ups about my feet. We need His help to turn the work in Valledupar over to someone. There is a great need for laborers in Colombia. We have a burden to prepare young people called by the Lord to serve in the ministry.
