I want to begin this first official letter by thanking God for what He has done. Our journey officially began with the executive board voting us in as a Director on August 17. Not many people knew that just the week before the board met, I was unemployed. At this point, I did not know if I would even be accepted or not with Macedonia World Baptist Missions. I have watched God provide for others and our family, time and time again.

I will not lie and say that it has been easy, but God has been FAITHFUL! Pray that God will continue to open doors for us and that in His time, we can begin working full-time as the Director (we would love to by the end of next year)!
