- -VBS: February 29-March 2


If you would like to help towards camp, you can send any gift to Macedonia marked, "Stover Special Funds." The cost to sponsor one teenager is \$35.

Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

My name is Robert Stover and for those of you who may not know me, my family and I have served as church-planting missionaries in Peru since 2008. We currently serve in the city of Tacna. I am privileged to represent the Tacna Christian School Project that was started by our co-laborer Missionary Bethany Homan, who went home to be with the Lord this year following a lengthy battle with cancer. It is my desire with the Lord's help to carry on with the vision that God gave Bethany.

We appreciate so much the generous giving of many that has allowed the school property to be purchased, a security wall to be constructed along the perimeter, and the water and sewer systems to be prepared. Pastor Henry Sucapuca is the faithful Peruvian pastor who is helping with the administration of the project here. After much prayer and consideration, we want to inform you of the first phase of the school project.

Currently, there is approximately \$36,000 available in the school fund. We believe that first step forward would be to begin a daycare in 2024. This project would cost between \$4-5,000. It is our thought that this would be a good method of school advertisement in the community. The daycare would be self-supporting once the initial construction is complete.

Here in Peru, the cost of building the first floor of a permanent structure is considerably more expensive than building upper floors. Due to the frequent earthquakes we experience, it is necessary to invest in a strong foundation. Added to this, the cost of building materials has risen since Covid. We plan to divide the construction in various phases to make the costs more manageable. Having said that, we know God is able!

According to our architect's estimate, the first phase (which would include 3 classrooms, bathrooms, and a teacher's room) would cost around \$105,000. This is half of the first floor we would plan to eventually construct and would allow us to begin three preschool classes. We would need to raise the additional \$75,000 by the month of April or May to be able to complete the construction, inspections, and paperwork in time for the new school year to begin in March of 2025.

Please pray for us concerning this great opportunity and also for the Lord's direction in regards to many decisions that must be made. Pray God would be preparing even now those who will teach and minister at the school. We desire God to be glorified in every detail of this project.
