OUR REPORT: Greetings to our faithful partners in the fellowship of the Gospel. You will notice an updated letterhead with a current photo of our family. We have been on the field here in Oregon since July 23, 2022 and did not realize how much the children have grown. This year will mark 14 years of marriage for Carrie and I, if God permits us to live until March the 5th. I am thankful for the home and family the Lord has given me; they are a blessing to my life and to the ministry here. The children are growing so fast; Noah is 11 years old, Elsie is 8, and Emma is 5. We are all doing well and God's grace sustains us day by day.

Our present focus in the ministry here is that of laying the foundation of Clearview Baptist Church (1 Cor. 3:10).
