## Young People

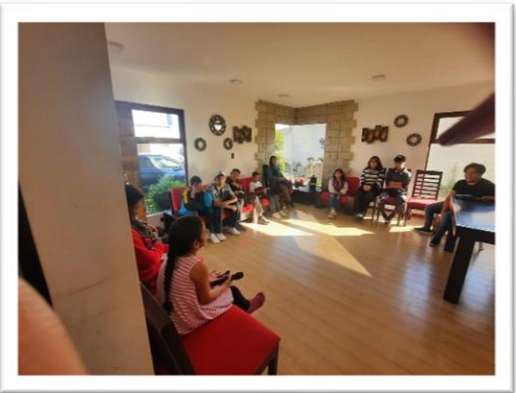
