Family —

The Wilson family continues to see God's unending blessings! We are happy to announce that we are expecting our first baby boy due in late June 2024! This is a tremendous answer to prayer! We are planning on having the baby in Papua New Guinea, so please pray for a safe and healthy pregnancy and delivery!

The Church —

New Home Baptist Church continues to see the hand of God in their operations. As mentioned before, in November, we ordained Brother Amos George to be the pastor for New Home Baptist Church. Brother Amos and his family are faithful servants to the Lord, and they are doing a great job leading the church according to the scriptures. Please pray for the church and their new pastor. Opposition will increase, but so will the faithfulness of God!

Furlough —

At the end of November, we departed PNG to begin our furlough. On the way back, we stopped in Taiwan and spent a week visiting Brother Keith Cullers and his wife Jeanette. It was a great time of refreshing and gleaning of wisdom from a seasoned missionary couple. We are now two months into our furlough, and we have seen the Lord provide us with many needs met and several more supporting churches. The Lord has provided a new boat and engine for the island ministry as well as much of the funds for a solar kit for our house on the island. We express thanks to so many people who sacrificially gave so Milne Bay can have a gospel witness, and thanks be to God for faithfully providing for His servants! We are also thankful for the much-needed fellowship we have enjoyed since being back in the States.

Future Ministry —

Please continue praying for our future work on Normanby Island. As mentioned before, we have acquired some land at a village called Kwanaura for future ministry in Milne Bay. There, we will be setting up a base of operations for church-planting in the province. This includes: our house, a training center, and guest houses for students and visitors. We already have 15 men confirmed to attend the Bible school on the island to be trained to become ministers of the gospel. While training these men, we will be preaching from village to village and island to island with the intent of gathering converts from each area into local churches. Following the Lord's wisdom, we will have sufficiently-trained men to pastor these future new churches. We have witnessed the hand of God in our work at New Home, and we anticipate seeing Him do more wonderful things in the islands.
