I have also been confined to our property along with the little girls. Emily's nurse from the hospital has made the trip every 3 months to bring her medicine and check on her. Such a kind gesture and takes a great deal of courage.

We are thrilled to have Missy and Miriam here with us during this time. That makes 25 of us here at home. Sarah, Julianne and Gilbert are staying in the village to help Fritzner and Rolanne. I cannot express enough how much of a blessing Fritzner and Rolanne are to us. They along with Gilbert and Sarah purchase all our supplies, and Jeso brings them to us. I do on some Wednesdays send David and Daniel with one of the older boys to the Des Palmis open market for little needed things. Everything has become very expensive and terribly hard to find. Today, Gary made a special trip to the village to take Rolanne some sugar. None to be found at all. So glad we had some to share with her.

Pastor DeMil has faithfully been able to arrive and have services with us. Sure is a blessing to safely see him come through that gate along with everyone else. In December, Sè Ambrose accepted Christ as her Savior. She is such a sweet elderly lady. Please pray for her. She grew up in a family who serves Satan and is fighting a great battle. How sad to think what she must be going through. Oh, the awful things she used to call me! Now when we pray with her, she needs to be very near me and takes my hand. Sweet Smiles. Only God!!
