It was a very busy end of 2023 for us. Both churches, from our missions' conference were able to take on a new missionary. The Christmas ministry in the public schools went well this year. We had 34 sessions in schools and around 3,500 students and teachers heard the Christmas story and the gospel. It is such an encouragement when we play the question and answer game at the end of the program and they are able to answer the questions correctly about Christ's birth.
