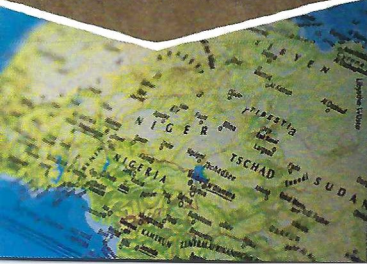

Greetings in the name of the Lord,

April 2024

Family- Deborah and the boys are doing well. They are in school trying to get everything done. We have seen some very hot days, and the lights have gone off for several hours at the same time almost every other day. The country hasn't paid their power supply bill, and we are getting power outages. It has been mid 80s to 90s with the real feel temperature around 105ish. So if the power is off at night, we sweat ha ha. Joshua is getting taller and is almost as tall as I am. Joseph will be 17 next month; I can't believe it. Last week, we were able to take a mini two day vacation; it was much needed.

Ministry

The church- We are up and down in attendance with many promising they will come but don't. We have had a visitor; we are praying for his salvation. The Saturday morning Bible club has been going well with some starting to answer questions at the end of the story. Deborah and Tonya Kenney have been doing that for several years now.

Other ministries- We have been going out to surrounding villages trying to give the gospel out. As we evangelize here, it is easy to see that most don't know anything about the gospel and how to get saved. There is very little Bible knowledge in our area, and what they do know is out of context. It has been a great fight when we witness because many use similar language but have no understanding as tradition, culture and false doctrine have been embedded in our people for years. There are some that just will not go to a church started by a white man.

The radio station- This has been the greatest of our outreaches as we are able to go into cities and villages that I can't physically get into. There are so many. When we go out witnessing, we give them our radio times, Friday at 9pm and Wednesday at 5:30am. The Friday night is only in English, but the Wednesday morning is translated into the local language so that everyone within about an hour and a half has the potential to hear if they are listening to the radio. I preach against the false doctrine and major on salvation. I have been told that even some of those false preachers have been listening to the program. I have been on the radio for about 8 years now; so there are those that follow. The problem with the radio station is that there is no way to know what God is doing or going to do through it, but everything we do is by faith so we preach and go.

Printing- A few months ago I printed out a verse by verse study through the book of Romans. I have just started one on Acts, and we have a local printer that can put it in soft cover form. The printing of it isn't expensive, and I will use these to help our people who have an interest to be able to read and study. I have been able to get them in some other churches' hands for their people as well.

Prayer- Pray for a young man named James and another named Amouse that they might be saved. I have witnessed to many in this village, but even other missionaries tell me our village is very difficult. Pray for our church members. We have some that have become unfaithful because of the pull of the world, the flesh, and the devil. Pray for our church land as I am going to resubmit the paperwork soon. It was rejected last time.
