Since starting deputation at the end of May 2023, we have traveled through 11 states, driven almost 20 thousand miles, went through 4 oil changes, a set of brake pads and are nearing the need of a set of tires. Since beginning full time deputation in January 2024, the Lord has blessed and showed His faithfulness. We have yet to miss paying a bill or having a meal. We are approaching the 30 percent mark of our goal. We have been in some amazing meetings. Through it all we have found that God is still moving. He is still on the throne. Churches across the southeast are having revival, and we have been blessed to be a part of many of these wonderful services.

The Lord has kept us safe through all our travels and for the most part we haven't been sick or injured. Praise the Lord. We have discovered that the van we have is too small for our family. We are looking for a passenger van, and unfortunately, they are not cheap. We have found that the average price for a used van is between \$20 to \$30k. Please help us pray for a bigger vehicle.

Please help us pray for our youngest daughter, Melody. She has been asking about salvation. She is 5 years old. I would hate to go to Iceland to preach the gospel and lose my own child to Hell. Also, please pray for Nickoli for an unspoken request.

To every church that has trusted us and is already supporting us, thank you so much. We are honored to have you partner with us in reaching Iceland. It has been a real encouragement to see the Lord using churches, from the smallest to the bigger ones, across the country to get the gospel around the world. We are all in this together to see lost souls saved. All the miles we have traveled, the long nights and early mornings and everything that is to come whether good or bad, will all be worth it all if we can just see one soul saved in Iceland.
