The late Dr. Marshall H. Everett:

In 1977, Dr. Marshall Everett, founder and chancellor of MWBM along with the executive board, voted to purchase a small print shop in Lawrenceville, GA to meet the printing needs of the mission board.



In 1978, Missionary Printer David Wade started printing gospel tracts and thus began the ministry of Macedonia Gospel Publications International. Over the years the ministry has grown to reach millions for Christ in many countries and languages.

The late Dr. Thurman Wade:

Formerly the General Director of MWBM, Dr. Wade wrote about the great need for Gospel literature. He wrote: "...the conversion of Hudson Taylor through the reading of a gospel tract resulting in hundreds of mission-



aries going to China, which had a profound effect on the whole nation. This kind of an event could be told time and again of others whose lives were changed through the printed page." (Focus on the Field, June 1994)

The late Dr. Carl Braswell:

Formerly the Director of MGPI, Dr. Braswell, who is now with the Lord, asked the question, "Are we (Bible believing Christians) going to continue to make the mistake in underestimating the power of the printed page?"

We see a resurgence in the use of Gospel tracts. As before Covid, there are more churches ordering tracts. In November one Military Ministry ordered 150,000 tracts which have been delivered.

Mexico and Central America:

We just finished folding an order for 300,000 Spanish tracts going to the Texas border. Those tracts will be dispersed throughout Mexico and Central America through the ministry of Latin American Outreach in Mission, Texas, Brother Noe Mendoza had worked with Brother Carl Braswell for several years using our tracts for



their ministry. Our MGPI volunteers have diligently cut, folded and boxed up this massive order and it will ship out soon.

Burkino Faso French Tracts:

Another large order is in the works. 500,000 French tracts are going to Burkino Faso, West Africa. Brother Jason Rishel will be shipping a container to this mission field soon, so time is of the essence. This rush order is now being cut down, folded and boxed up. Thank the Lord for faithful volunteers.
