Calvary Baptist Church in Hartlepool (in the Northeast) which was planted out of our church years ago by the Pavitts had an exciting leadership changeover in January. In answer to much prayer, Englishman Rob Smith and his wife Amanda (originally from Virginia) moved to help a year ago, and is now officially pastor. In spite of Colin Pavitt's long battle with cancer, they have started a new effort nearby in the seaside town of Seaham.

Two ladies recently had babies. Natalie organised baby showers for them, and we are excited to have these precious little ones in the congregation. We also found out two more ladies in the church are expecting as well! We praise God for this gift of life.

I experienced the trip of a lifetime in Zimbabwe. After being donated some beautiful pieces of property, our friends from Crown Christian Heritage Trust started Victoria Falls Baptist Church. The opportunities there have been amazing! We pray the Lord continues to provide more labourers for His wonderful work that can be done there. Many local pastors were thrust into positions without training when Mugabe kicked out many missionaries. The main reason I was invited was to help train 120 pastors at a teaching conference, as well as help preach and provide physical needs in nearby villages during a time of great drought. Some of the highlights were leading around two dozen individuals to Christ, teaching Sunday School in the open air, not to mention the beauty of Victoria Falls, which I'd always dreamed of visiting, and seeing some of Africa's amazing animals!

While I was in Zimbabwe, one of our most faithful and encouraging members, George Waugh's cancer rapidly worsened. I was able to see him when I got home just before he passed on to Glory. As a former butler at nearby Burghley House (the grandest of England's stately homes from the 1500's), they allowed us to have the funeral in the chapel there, and even lowered the flags to half mast across the estate. George used to have a morning Bible study there with other workers, and throughout the years has been known as an encouraging lay preacher and lover of the Lord's soon return. Of course, we were able to remind everyone he didn't miss the Rapture, for the dead in Christ will indeed "rise first!"

We have supported Jean "Johnny" Basedeke as a local missionary and evangelist for the last couple years, and he has an amazing gift of gathering young people around him in the city centre to hear the Gospel. I have been training him in our School of the Bible each week the last three years. At the end of March, he graduated and preached his first sermon! Sadly, he was not able to meet the new higher financial requirements to bring his fiancé in to the UK for their wedding, so last week, I took Johnny to the airport to move back to Kenya for his wedding. We pray he can find a good local church there in Nairobi and continue to spread the Gospel for God's glory.

Mihaela was saved in November and has been faithfully coming and growing in the Lord, along with her two beautiful girls. She gave a powerful testimony of salvation at her baptism on Easter Evening, with unsaved family and some Muslim friends in attendance.

Just before he left, Johnny led Kieron to the Lord, who has been coming along with his brother and friend. Pray for them all to be saved and to continue growing in the Lord.

The Youth Group continues to meet fortnightly and many teens take part in soul winning, singing, special music, and Scripture reading. We took many to a Youth Rally in Birmingham, where we went bowling and heard about "Standing In the Gap."
