Dear Fellow Laborers,

March-April 2024

Faith: In our last letter we reported that we would be traveling to New Hampshire with Noah Gudger, our newest church planter. We were blessed to travel safely to New England arriving on April 15th with a twofold purpose to look at available spaces to begin services and attend the annual "Save New England Conference" that was hosted by veteran church planters. This year's meeting was held at the Granite State Baptist Church with Pastor Peter Champerland in Concord, New Hampshire. The conference was attended by pastors and experienced church planters from various states. This was a wonderful opportunity for us to see and hear from men with a burden for the six New England States. We were encouraged by each service and the messages. On Tuesday, we drove about an hour to Peterborough, NH for Noah to see the Peterborough Town Library that has large rooms available for rent. We also visited a community center, a gym, and a recreation facility. Out of these possibilities the library seems to be the better choice.



At the end of March, we were able to update one of our supporting churches in Bradenton, Florida, Legacy Baptist, that has been faithfully supporting us for over 10 years. It was a blessing to meet Pastor Brett Bell for the first time.

On Sunday night April 7th, Pastor Muse and the sweet people of Vision honored us with a "Thank You" fellowship. We appreciate the opportunity God gave us to serve there for almost 4 years and look forward to what God has in store for them.



Family: The first weekend in March we were able to attend our sister Linda's 80th birthday celebration with about 50 friends and family. The events of the following weeks were a whirlwind to say the least. Our house was off the market for several days, which allowed Cathy to adjust to the new routine with her mom, who had just been released from rehab. Our oldest sister Sandra, who is in a memory care facility, had her 81st birthday which we attended on Friday, March 15th. Our house went back on the market Thursday evening, and on Friday, Cathy called to say that someone was interested. Because God had us in Georgia already, we made an appointment to look at some houses near Augusta. We received an offer on our house Friday, and we chose a house in North Augusta on Saturday (Cathy only saw pictures). We closed on the Florida house April 18th and the South Carolina house April 19th. God's hand was so evident in the process. We had loaded a pod before leaving for New Hampshire, but Pastor Muse and the people of Vision took care of securing a larger than expected truck, loaded it and had it ready when we returned late Wednesday night. Mom Ruby was able to stay in a hospice facility for 6 nights, and Cathy's sister Susan flew down from Columbia to help care for her as well as drive our car for the move. We share all these details to show how God has once again orchestrated His plan for our lives. We are blessed to be closer to family members who can help Cathy with caregiving. We could have never pictured all that has taken place, but we are so grateful for the outcome.



Future: The future is always bright when we are in God's will. We will continue to encourage our 9 USA East Team members by phone calls, visiting them on the field, and helping them as they have need.
