Praise the Lord and thanks be to God for another opportunity to give you an update of what God's doing here in the ministry. The Harvest Baptist Church is going strong here in Santa Fe, New Mexico. We have recently finished remodeling our auditorium and now are making plans to start remodeling the dining hall. The people are faithful, and a steady stream of visitors is coming in consistently. His Harvest Ministries, the church planting arm of Harvest Baptist Church, is going forward for the glory of God. Within the church plants we have Gallinas River Baptist Mission in Las Vegas, NM every week. We recently saw a young lady get saved in one of the services a few weeks ago here. The Lord has laid it on a pastor's heart in Florida to move out and join Harvest Baptist Church and work with me in this young church plant. The plans are for him to become the pastor within a year's time. The church plant would then be constituted and turned over to him as the pastor. Brother Eduardo Orozco, our church planter in the central part of Chihuahua state, is doing well. They're building construction is going forward at the church plant in the village of Samaloapan, and we've recently rented out a building for the church in the town of Santa Isabel where they are holding services now. Brother Charlie Powell will be starting his initial launch service on the 7th of July. At which time we will have gone down to the town of Janos, Chihuahua, Mexico and helped him with an evangelistic campaign the week before. Please pray for the success of this new work. Brother Jose Valenzuela has seen nine people saved in the last week at the church plant in Casas Grandes, Chihuahua, Mexico. Continue to pray for these men, their financial support, their families and ministries. If God leads you to personally support these men, please contact me as they are all worthy of that investment. We will be going to Antonito, Colorado in the next couple weeks and holding an evangelistic campaign. Several communities will be witnessed to through door knocking and one-on-one personal evangelism. Our prayer is that through the night services and the daily evangelism that there will be those that would receive Jesus as their Savior. Our prayer is that this could be the start of another church plant in a very needed area of our country. Antonito is located approximately 2 hours north of Santa Fe. The area is mostly Catholic, Mormon and Amish.

Before we close, I would like to bring to your attention two great financial needs we have in our ministry at the moment. The first being the church building in Casas Grandes that we have been constructing. We have purchased the land and brought water and power on the property, as well as almost finished building the first building. This will serve as a parsonage/temporary church building until the main church building is finished. Because the prices of materials have gone up in Mexico as well as the value of the dollar going down in the United States, we will need to raise probably another \$15,000 to complete the main church building. Please be much in prayer for this need, and if God leads you to invest in this project, it would be much appreciated.

The second financial need is we are currently raising money for a small warehouse located on the border of New Mexico and Chihuahua. The property is located on an acre of land. It has water, power and a septic tank already installed as well as a small Quonset hut. This would be used as a holding station for printed materials, building supplies, can goods and church equipment for the works in Mexico. As the works have grown the need for supplies has grown as well. The supplies have come in, but finding a place to store them in the meantime is a great need. This warehouse facility is expandable and can be used as a missions apartment along with a warehouse facility. The owner is asking \$21,000. We have had the equivalent of approximately \$6,000 committed so far. This property would expand the ministry and make the process of getting supplies to the field a whole lot simpler. We have till August to raise the money before the owner places the property on the market. Once again, if God would lead you to invest in this, I know that it would pay back great dividends of spiritual value for all eternity.

Our family is growing, and currently our two oldest boys are at the Who Will Go Mission Camp in Roanoke, Alabama. Please pray for our kids that their heart for God will continue to grow and that God would use them mightily in His future. God bless you and thank you for your support and prayers.
