We spent a weekend there at the church and then continued our journey east. We made it safely to Georgia on September 25th. We praise the Lord for traveling mercies for thousands of miles across the United States. That weekend we traveled to Pensacola, FL to get a new family picture made with Jason. We spent the next few weeks in Georgia close to our mission board as we prepared to begin furlough.

During this time, I was also able to help deliver 3 trips worth of supplies to parts of western NC that were heavily hit by the hurricane. It was a blessing to be just a small part of helping these many churches and families. Please keep western NC in your prayers as they continue to recover and start to rebuild from the hurricane.

October 21st-25th we were at Zion Hill Baptist Church in Greenville, SC for a church planter's conference that was taught by two fellow missionaries. It was a blessing to be around so many church planters that week with a zeal to see souls saved and churches planted!

On October 26th, we traveled to North Carolina. We have our RV parked here and will be traveling to visit supporting churches and new churches. We are on furlough until next summer.
