In October we began our 3rd round of English classes. This outreach has garnered a lot of interest and we already have a list of those who would like to enroll in our next round. As with all ministries of the church, we use these classes to reach others with the Gospel. Each round consists of 3 sessions of 8 classes each. Each 2.5 hour class is divided into Grammar, Phonics, and Conversation. We always have a devotional time, teach them a hymn in English, and invite them to church numerous times. I know that God is, and will continue to be, working through these classes.
