LIVING HOPE BAPTIST CHURCH (Atizapan, Mexico State)

The church has been growing. We have seen more faithful participation and spiritual growth of some keys families. It is such a blessing to see someone like **Isai and Marta get more involved** and grow in their walk with God.

Jose & Liliana have been such a great help as leaders in the church while we are in this transition period of having to attend to 2 churches. Jose is in his last year of the Bible Institute and was hired part time by the church, preaching and teaching the Word. His wife, Liliana, has been working as a part time secretary for years now. He is a general contractor by trade and is helping with the church property project also.

LIVING HOPE "PROMISED LAND" PROPERTY PROJECT

The church has sacrificially given 18 monthly payments (out of 24), towards the payoff of the property. They have also been involved in temporary construction projects. God has provided through the generosity of His people 3 of the 4 larger 6 month payments. Our LAST payment of \$5,000 is due in September. The next goal is to begin permanent construction by June 1st. To do so we need at least 20,000 pesos (about 1,000 USD) for permits and the initial phase which we have about 3/4 of it. This Sunday, we are taking up a special offering to complete that goal. We have already begun drawing up our plans to submit to the architect. Thank you each and every one of you who has given to help us have a permanent home for the church and Bible Institute.
