Greetings from Taiwan Praise the Lord for a good Easter program at many schools and nursing home facilities. This year around 1,600 people heard the resurrection story. Every year when we have these special outreach services at Christmas and Easter it seems there are special blessings that come in special ways. This year it was with the school principals. Several of them commented after hearing and seeing the program how they never knew all about the resurrection before. I had the privilege of witnessing very thoroughly to some of them. We pray God will continue to work in their hearts as well as the students. We also saw a couple people from the nursing homes pray to believe in Christ.

I just returned from Hong Kong after teaching for a week. Twenty-four pastors and church workers from China were in the class. Sometime during the week, Paul's imprisonment came up. I asked if any of them had been in prison. One said his Bibles and Christian books were taken. One said he had been beaten by the police. Another said he was put in prison for having a suitcase full of tracts. May we never forget the freedom we have to witness for Christ. Some pay a much higher price than we do. The few hours most believers spend in church or witnessing for Christ seems so small in comparison.

We are planning on a 4 month furlough, September through December, 2025. The past few times we came back to the States has only been for a few months each time. We know we have many supporting churches we have not visited for a long time. We'd like to be able to see them this time if they would like for us to come.
