Cesar, Colombia. We thank the Lord for the help He has given us to be able to share the gospel in the midst of the darkness that surrounds us. Our theme verse for this year is Phil. 2:15 which states "as lights in the world."

Support Group From Mexico

I had written in our last Prayer Letter that a group from Mexico had arrived and was busy helping us here. Truly, we are taught of the Lord to "go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in." We saw the advantage of being in a small group and headed out to preach the gospel wherever we could.

There are several barrios called "invasions" where groups of people live in housing that was built without consent of the owners. There are people there that are internal refugees from the conflicts here in Colombia as well as many that are from Venezuela.

As we contacted different areas and different groups, great numbers raised their hands to say that they had prayed and asked the Lord to save them. It has been a great encouragement for all the Church to see things picking back up again. Following up, we have helped with transportation and a brief discipleship. Some have been making a sincere effort to attend. Several followed the Lord in believers' baptism. The building is filling up.
