We are making plans to head West to get ready for our Orientation School that will be in July in Buffalo, Wyoming. We are expecting about 15 families this year. We will be having classes for the adults, VBS for their children, and evening church services. It will be a busy and refreshing time.

Please keep us in your prayers. One thing necessary for our travels is having to have some mechanical work done on our truck. It is in the shop right now having the engine rebuilt. This is a costly repair but is still a lot cheaper than a newer truck. We have over 200,000 miles on it, and the mechanic says when they are finished we should be able to get another 200,000.

Our health problems are somewhat better. I have had a second stint in my heart. I can tell a big difference since that. Sister Hutchens is still scheduled for more tests, but she is feeling a lot better. Pray we can get all these done promptly so we can head West. We want to keep serving our Saviour, but at 78 and 79, these old bodies have an increase in pain. There is still so much work to be done until Jesus comes.

Thank you for all your prayers and financial support. We love you, our brothers and sisters in Christ.
