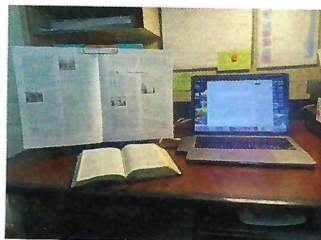

Our 3rd English class graduated in February. We had 11 finish all 3 levels and receive their certificate. We will begin a new session in September after school has started and our teachers are ready to take on the classes. This is an amazing outreach into the community, and we have had some ask us about in going into areas around us to have remote lessons. We are willing, but right now lack the time and teachers to do it. It is a time consuming job and one that gives me quite the headache at times, but knowing that what I am doing now will benefit the church for years to come makes it all worthwhile. In May we will be having our Faith Promise Missions Conference and hosting a large group from the U.S. The beginning of June will be our 3rd Kindergarten graduation, and the end of June we will be having our 3rd annual Medical Brigade.
