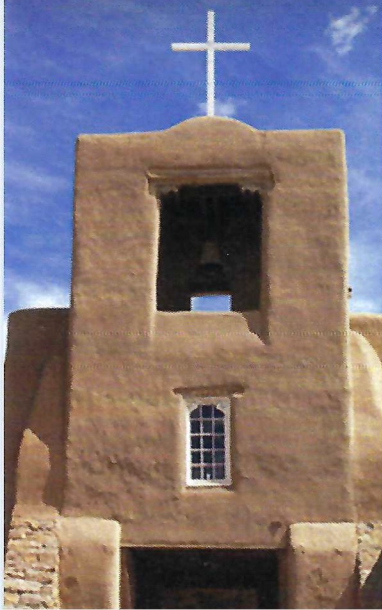

Spring-Summer 2025

Well, praise the Lord for all His goodness. Since our last prayer letter, we have been busy and progressing in many projects. After our last report, I, Mrs. Courtney and our 2 oldest boys visited Missionary Gene Trask in Honduras. What a wonderful work he is doing in a very remote region in that country. Truly, it is a pioneer field on many levels. It was a blessing to invest in our sons for those 2 weeks. My oldest son Clint will be going next winter to intern with Bro. Trask for 6 weeks. I praise the Lord for what he is doing in our family.

Upon returning from Honduras, we jumped right into finishing the remodel of the dining hall here at Harvest Baptist Church. We are thankful for all the hard work from the people of Harvest Baptist. On Resurrection Sunday, we had a grand opening and ribbon cutting ceremony. The people rejoiced and were excited for this long awaited project to be accomplished. During the banquet, we brought 2 more church planting families into the membership of Harvest Baptist and on board with His Harvest Ministries (which is the church planting arm of our church). The Pachecos are starting 2 churches in Chihuahua, Chihuahua, Mexico. These 2 missions are meeting in 2 different homes, and we are praying to relocate them soon to rented buildings to meet in. The Monterubio family have arrived in Tlaltenango, Zacatecas, Mexico. They are currently searching for an apartment to live in and start the church. These two families bring the church plant count coming out of Harvest Baptist to 12 church plants. There are a couple more in the process, so be praying for those to come to fruition. Continue to pray for the Valinzqula family, Orazco family, Powell family and the Matheson family as they are serving the Lord currently in our church planting ministry.

Here is a list of needs to pray with us about. Pray for Bro. Charlie Powell to find a place to meet at his second mission church in Monta Verdi, Chihuahua, Mexico. He is doing evangelistic work every week there. He desperately needs to find a place to assemble in this town. Pray we can raise the funds for the second phase of the Casas Grandis property. We finished the parsonage/temporary auditorium last year. We need to move forward into building the permanent auditorium this year. We estimate the cost will be a total of about \$25,000. We plan to receive some offerings at the Harvest Baptist Church for this at the beginning of the summer. I recently acquired a F- 450 truck that will be used for personal use, as well as taking the loads of tracts and Bibles to Mexico. It will also be utilized to take church planting packages to the men from our warehouse property we are buying in Columbus, NM. This truck needs some engine work that will probably cost around \$10,000. This is a need that we know God will provide. Bro Orazco's mission church in Samiloapan, Chihuahua, Mexico has a construction need. They are currently meeting in a house that belongs to a member. They have a lot that has been donated, and they have installed the foundation. It will take about \$12,000 to finish this building. If God would lay it on your heart to help contribute to any of these projects, please stipulate the amount and which project when contributing through Macedonia.

Praise the Lord for your continual support. Pray for the Rogers family and His Harvest Ministries.
