I want to thank each of you for your prayers and support.

Deborah and the boys are hard at school for the year. Joseph just turned 18, and Jeremiah just turned 12. Joseph is finishing his senior year in high school; he will stay for another year until we go home on furlough at the end of next year. This is an exciting time and sad as well. Joshua is working hard in school, and they are all ready for this school year to end.

Deborah has been working hard with Tonya Kenney on our Saturday Bible club. We have had many children be faithful but are not yet saved. She has been working with several young girls that we are praying for.

I have been busy preaching on the radio every Friday night. I usually try to get an extra slot on holidays. The radio allows us to preach all over our Western region. I was able to take a few Bible school students and two other pastors to Tamale in the Northern region on a survey trip. It was very similar to Mali and Burkina Faso. Pray for that area as there was only one church that was close to a fundamental church in that area. We have been going out witnessing every Saturday morning and in villages around us. We have started going out on Thursdays witnessing in our village; it has proven sad. We have witnessed to pastors, elders, and church goers who have no idea what the gospel is. When we witness to our people they can't grasp the doctrines of faith and simple belief in Christ alone. Our people have been taught works, and thus many live in sin. I have been trying in every way to get the gospel to our people, but there are so many false teachings surrounding us.

We have been able to have some teen events with other churches around us. This has been good for our church kids; pray for them as some have gone away from the Lord. We have seen a few returning. Pray for Amouse; he has been going to the radio station with me most Friday nights, but he needs to be saved. Pray for Ange and her sister; they are from the Ivory Coast and have been faithful, but I am not sure they are saved. Pray for Erica and Judeth; these two girls need to be saved as well. We have had the grandparents of 3 of our kids come, but they aren't saved either. Pray for the grandfather; if he were saved, it would change the family. Pray for our area, as I know hundreds of people, but most will never visit our church. Pray that I get more opportunities to witness to them.

When I ask for prayer, it is because without it we can't do anything. We are still working on paperwork for land we bought twice. Everything in our village is a struggle; we need God and only God to move.
