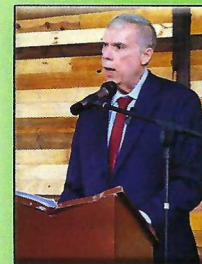
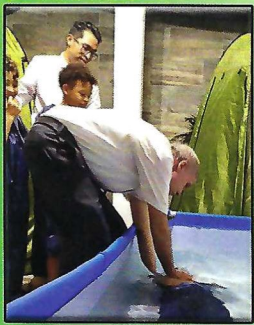
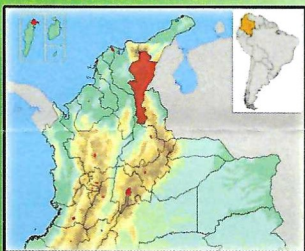


THE HART FAMILY IN COLOMBIA
