Hello dear friends and faithful supporters,

We are excited to report what God has allowed us to be part of these past three months. It has been a very eventful and productive quarter.

April began with a trip to Alabama to help my brother-in-law, Jonathan Head, set up their new camper as they begin deputation to go to Winner, SD, as church planters. While there, we participated in a missions conference with the Head family in Valley, AL. This was a special time for Sis. Deanna, as it was the first time she and her sister were in a meeting together as missionaries. We spent Resurrection Sunday with our home church and attended a special meeting that same week. We ended April in Kentucky at a new church's camp meeting, where we were invited to attend. Praise the Lord, they later voted to take us on for support!

While in Kentucky, Sis. Deanna had a diverticulitis attack and was hospitalized for four days. The church where we were parked was incredibly kind and made sure we had everything we needed and more. They graciously let us stay through her recovery.

In May and early June, we were honored to attend the Who Will Go? Leadership Meeting and then two full weeks of camp in Lineville, AL. At camp, we assisted with setup, cooking, devotions, teaching, real-life scenarios, and more. During those two weeks, several young people announced their call to missions, many surrendered to whatever God has for them, and all were deeply challenged by the missionary testimonies and preaching. Our two oldest children attended and were greatly impacted. Who Will Go? Camp is always a highlight of our year, and we count it a privilege to take part.

The day after camp ended, we started our journey to Van Buren, Maine. Though exhausted in body and mind after three intense weeks, we are grateful for a smooth 1,700 mile trip to be with the Stephen York family. We spent three weeks laboring alongside them. Bro. York asked me to teach "The 30-Minute Bible Study," a method that equips believers to

confidently witness to and teach others God's Word. It begins in Genesis with the fall of man and moves to redemption through Jesus Christ. That very evening, we heard from a church member who used the study to witness to their neighbor for an hour. Praise God for obedient hearts!

We also taught what's known as "The Ropes Course," which illustrates what the Bible says about false paths to Heaven and how true salvation comes only through repentance and faith in the Gospel. In addition to preaching and teaching several times, we canvassed local communities with door hangers, helped start their first "Free Bible" tent, and organized their first ever Vacation Bible School. We also completed several projects around the church to improve its appearance and structure. Thank you to everyone who gave toward this trip!

Thank you all for your continued prayers and support. We need them as we travel and labor through the rest of this year. Please be much in prayer for two upcoming trips. The first will take our family to the island of St. Vincent, where we'll work with missionary David Ballinger for a six-week Gospel push in multiple villages, holding tent meetings along the way. We have an opportunity to purchase our tickets at a great rate and would love to secure them before the price increases.

The second trip is scheduled for January, when we'll head to Cordova, Alaska, to labor with missionary Elijah Helms. We'll be spending the entire month there, serving and getting to know the Helms family and their ministry. Please join us in prayer for the finances and logistics for both of these trips to come together. We are excited to see all that God has planned.

Thank you again for your love, support, and prayers. Your faithfulness allows us to continue serving in the work to which God has called us.
