My family and I are beyond grateful for the opportunity we had to meet you and are excited to share what the Lord has been doing for us both in ministry and our personal lives.

The Lord has been good to our family, and we are grateful to Him for His goodness towards us. Our boys, Josiah and Jonathan, are growing graciously. However, we covet your prayers for our older son, Josiah, who as you know is autistic but is making great progress with his speech development.

Our ministry in St. Vincent and the Grenadines is not without its challenges, but despite those challenges, God has certainly been faithful. We are doing a discipleship course on Wednesday nights at Bethany Baptist Church where we are currently serving, with the hope to help equip the church to go out and reach their community.

We are excited to share with you that on July 6th, we had a baptism of 7 persons, 3 of which are the children of Missionary David Ballinger. The others are faithfully serving the Lord at Bethany Baptist Church. Please pray for them that they will continue to grow in the grace of God.



Through **The Every Village Project** and the **Who Will Go** School of Evangelism, headed by Bro. Chris Hewett, we have seen God start a church in the community of Layou (LAY-U) after a week of Bible distributions, witnessing throughout the community and night street meetings at the water front. We saw over 12 souls saved and a great number of persons curious in asking questions. For the past 3 Monday evenings, we have been having Bible study beneath our little tent by the water front. So far the attendance has been good with an average of 15 to 20 persons. We have been teaching on the purpose of the church. Please pray for the church plant in Layou, that God will provide us with a place where we can meet regularly.



Furthermore, we do covet all the prayers we can get for our country and communities due to the rise in violent crime, such as armed robbery and gun violence, that has rendered our communities not as safe as they used to be. This has affected our attendance at evening services because some of the women fear walking alone. Our desire is to purchase a mini bus to transport persons who would like to attend church services and to be used in the Every Village Project. Pray that the Lord will grant us this favor.

Help us pray concerning the next village and know that we are praying for you also, for we do serve an awesome and all powerful God who is according to Ephesians 3:20, "Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us." Surely, it is a blessing to serve the Lord with like-minded people who do doubtlessly care for the ministry of God. Blessings on thee!
