Emergency Room Dr. consulted with her Dr. she would need to see a Specialist of some sort, so sent her home with pain meds, but no answers. Two days later, Sandy discovers a rash, break out on her left side, she knew then it was Shingles, went to the Dr again to confirm. Took almost 3 weeks for the break out to show up. She has had a hard case of Shingles, very intense pain, as many know nerve pain is the worst of all. She has improved in the past 2 weeks, but there is that lingering pain that shows up, and the tingling, numbness in her left side. Dr says this can go on for weeks, even months.
