He and his family have been a blessing to us, and they are now allowing us to live in their home while they are in Germany. Our children have certainly enjoyed being able to unpack a lot of toys and other familiar things that have been in storage for a few months. Thank you all for praying for our housing situation.

As we continue to learn Dutch culture, we have come into contact with many new people over the last few months. The kindness that we have been shown in this place is beyond our imagination. We are so thankful for the contacts we have made since moving here, and we are excited to see these contacts blossom as we continue in beginning a ministry here. Our main focus continues to be learning Dutch. Although our Dutch has improved, we have a long way to go in becoming fluent in this language.

I have improved my ability to read Dutch, and I have started reading the Bible in Dutch to refine these skills. We have also been able to print some tracts to begin the tract ministry mentioned in our last letter.

There were some issues with translation that had to be corrected, but the tracts are now ready. I have also written a tract that will be sent for printing in the next week. Please pray for this ministry that it will yield fruit and reach many people. The Lord provided financing for the printing of the tracts through a supporting church and their VBS offering. Thank you!

We have had a busy few months with opportunities to preach in Belgium, attend meetings at different places, and go door knocking with a fellow missionary. We also had a wonderful time during visits from our Pastor a few weeks ago (with some goodies from our home church) as well as our Field Director from Macedonia. These visits were very encouraging.
