






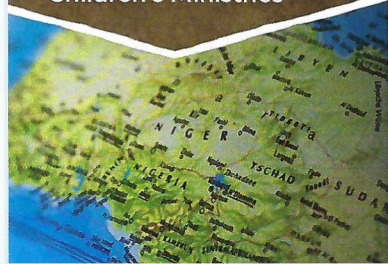

September 2025

There has been a lot going on over the last few months. Deborah has had a break for a few months, but we just started school back. Joseph graduated earlier this year, but it will be a year before we can go back and help him adjust to America. Joshua is starting 11th and Jeremiah is starting 7th. We have had a good break, but they are now back at it. It has been cold for the last few months because of the longer rainy season.

We had a good VBS this year with several first timers, but we only had my family and one worker this year which makes it harder. We were able to teach two messages a day for 3 days and had many good games, but as always, we were very tired afterward.

The radio ministry has always been a good constant for us. It has allowed us to get the gospel out over a huge part of our region as we are on probably the biggest antenna in our area. It is rare that we go out on visitation and people don't tell me they have heard me preach on the radio or that they regularly listen to the program. Over the years, we have allowed visiting pastors to preach on the station. We are going to start using some of the local Bible college students to preach once a month. If you want to see it, we are on SKYY Media Group Facebook page live on Friday nights. You can cycle back through and find a few messages, but I will warn it isn't a very Christian radio station. Most of the preaching on the station isn't close to Biblical.

The church land is still an unknown. We were promised it would be ready months ago, but like everything else here, there is much talk and little action.

The church has seen several setbacks as many have chosen the world over God. We have had a few of our guys take jobs that have taken them away, and one is off at high school. The good news is that we have more visitors, mostly children but a few adults. We have 2 mothers of the children that come from time to time which is a first for us. We still don't have any men as we have spoken to them, but they aren't responsive.

Most of the churches around us don't preach the Bible at all; some preach a perverted gospel. Most in our area excuse sin as preachers around us refuse to preach against it so that they can keep members.

Pray for Eric, Emmanuel, Michel, Koceche, Ezekiel, Ato, and Felix; most have been with us for years and walked away from God one by one.

Pray for Erica, Judith, Ange, Michelle, Amouse, Felicia, Desmond, Benidict, an older man and woman, and a few others that visit but aren't saved.

Pray as we try to help some area churches with evangelization.
