There are changes in government here and even recent changes in the last few weeks concerning the Ministry of the Interior that governs the legal processes of Churches and religions in Colombia. The doctor wants another evaluation of it in six months. Please pray we will find grace before God and man as we enter another year of renting the building the Church is now in.
