We were not able to go back to the US as we planned with our financial constraints and the need for me to reorganize and restructure the two public offices I have been appointed at.



Pray for Laguna Province

As the Lord has placed us in the Philippines specifically in the province of Laguna, we are intentional in fulfilling God's call and the opportunities he has opened for us.

As Laguna province is included in the area where half of the Philippine population is, we have a great window to reach them for the Lord

Based on estimates on recent data, we have over 3.6 million people in this province where the annual growth is 2.9% in the entire CALABARZON region. Laguna has the second most population.



Aside from being appointed as the Chief of the Laguna Traffic Management Office (LTMO), the Governor has also appointed me recently to another concurrent position as the Head of the Provincial Peace and Order Office (PPOO) overseeing and coordinating with all security forces and the interior local government executives.

With these, I have initially launched again the Moral Recovery Program (MRP) law and have organized pastors to pray for every government office and have a weekly 15-minute Bible study in their offices. I have placed our Youth Pastor Preacher Paolo Saucelo and Outreach Pastor Prch. Meynard Guevarra to spearhead this program Please pray that we can do the most for the Gospel in the positions the Lord has placed me.

Task Force TAGALIGTAS (SAVIOR) Ministry

Please pray for this ministry. The Lord has used this silently yet greatly in creating many in-roads in many security forces in the Philippines.



I am praying that many American Christian security personnel could come at this time and both train and provide tactical gears to different security units but help also witness and win them to the Lord.

The Lord has given me command and control over several tactical training facilities and have oversight to many security forces. I am praying for "warrior short-term missionaries" to visit and help minister to these "brothers-in-arms in military and lawenforcement".

It would be also a great blessing and help to hand them camouflaged Bibles. As of now I need at least 100,000 Bibles to be given to them
