November marked the halfway point of our furlough, and these months have been a special time of reporting to supporting churches, visiting with family and friends as well as updating many miscellaneous things necessary as part of returning to the USA after a four-year term. We are grateful for how God has provided housing, a vehicle, clothing and everything else we have needed. Our heartfelt thank you goes out to those who have so graciously given to meet the needs of this missionary family.

We appreciate your prayers for our daughter Stephanie as she makes ready to begin her studies at Pensacola Christian Collage in January 2026. Pray also for our son Frank as he works on finishing High School. Our prayer for all four of our children is that they will grow in the Lord and remain entirely focused on God's will for their lives.

We have received encouraging news from the field that several visitors have come to the church services, and two more families have joined the congregation. God has brought people to the church from the countries of Cuba, Venezuela and Paraguay to worship the Lord with the Brazilian brethren.

The construction project has continued, and by God's grace, we have completed the accessibility ramp on the front section leading up to the parking lot that has also been completed. At this time, we are having all the railing fabricated for the ramp and along the retention walls which is a necessary safety measure. There is one final need that we are praying the Lord will provide by the time of our return to Brazil in May, Lord willing, and that is the approximately \$12,000.00 needed to install the required wheelchair elevator, plus a few finishing items.
