We understand that we are living in difficult times and we do immensely thank you for your support, prayers and we praise the Lord for your faithfulness.

PRAYERS

- 1). Continue praying for my wife. She is being treated, for the weight loss and much progress is being made with the medicine she is taking plus some Probiotic vitamins.
- We are trusting in the Lord for His protection and provision (Physical, emotional, Financial, Spiritual).
- 2). Continue praying for the growth of the church and protection. Thank you for your prayers. We have now in regular attendance faithfully every Sunday 11 people. Praise the Lord!
