Dear Praying friends and supporters;

We are thankful that while we have been away from the work in Honduras, the men there have continued on reaching

out and preaching. On the 13th of November, Brother Levis and 9 or 10 people from the area of Kaukira rented a boat and motor and traveled over 3 hours to get to the village of Ahuasluhpia, a new mission work where Brother Humer is pastoring. They wanted to hold a meeting so as to encourage Bro. Humer and his family in the work there. Bro.



Andy and four people paid passage to come from Puerto Lempira, and Bro. Resly came in from the village of Auka. They had service Thursday evening, Friday and Saturday

morning, afternoon, and evening, and then morning and evening services on Sunday before going home. There were more than 20 people that participated in the meeting with another 30 or more coming in for the services. I provided the generator, light bulbs,

food, and gasoline, and the people took care of the rest. We are so thankful that the folks have grown spiritually to the point that they are able to put on and preach a meeting like this.

For our part here in the US, the Lord has allowed us to be on the road the Sunday after Dad's funeral till the Wednesday before Thanksgiving. We have been able to be in 4 new churches, 1 of which took us on for support while we were there, and 8 supporting churches, zigzagging 3,500 miles or more. We have been able to be in a missions conference, Christian day school, youth meeting, as well as regular services. Preaching, presenting, teaching Sunday School, and just spending time with pastors

and their wives. We pray we have been an encouragement to some along the way. Without question they have been a great encouragement to us as we have visited. The Lord has also blessed with us being able to add around 50 people to our "Pray Mail" list. Thank you for those of you who have been praying for us, as well as those of you who this might be your first letter. May God bless you for your prayers.

Our time here in the US is winding down fast. We have 4 scheduled meetings in December and 2 in January, outside of being at our home church, before flying out the 20th of January. The Lord has blessed us and worked in our hearts during this time in. As we look forward to being able to get with all of our kids and grandkids this Christmas season, we pray that the Lord will give us opportunities to tell folks along the way about His wonderful love.
