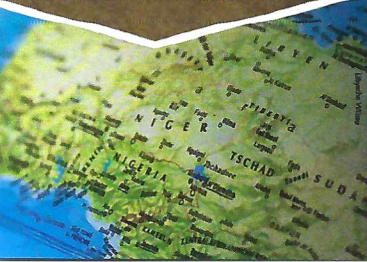

Greetings in the name of the Lord,

I want to thank everyone for their support and prayers for our family and the ministry here in Ghana.

Joseph finished school and is now going through the Bible with me this year. We will finish studying through it together and will furlough at the end of the year. Joseph will not be coming back with us after furlough and will begin his future in the States. This transition will not be easy on Deborah and me. Joshua will return with us for a year and go through the Bible with me, and then we will take a 3-month furlough to get him adjusted, and then he will stay in the States. He is now 16. Jeremiah is busy in school, and Deborah is trying her best to get Joshua and Jeremiah through school. She will be glad when homeschooling is over. Ha Ha

This past year has met with many challenges as we have seen several of our faithful young men walk away from God and go into the world. That has been very sad as I warned them repeatedly, yet they wouldn't hear.

In November, we had our 10th anniversary at Kansaworodo Independent Baptist Church. We saw two young ladies that have been with us for a few years get saved in September, I think it was. For the 10th anniversary, we had a meal and a meeting that went Sunday through Wednesday night. We were able to have 3 local national pastors to preach for us, and we decorated everything nice. We have had two women coming to church for awhile. They have been very helpful in the church, and I have been grateful for adults. Jennifer has grown much in the Lord, and I am praying her sister Anita will go further for God this year. Pray for Papa as he is struggling because of worldly pressure and pressure from friends. Pray for Koseche and Ebenezer as they haven't been to church in a little while. The world pulls hard at our people.

I have been preaching on the radio for about 10 years now every Friday night at 9pm. Because I am preaching a lot, I have started to invite area pastors and young preachers to preach every 3 weeks or so that I might encourage others. November was also very busy because an opportunity opened up to preach on a new satellite TV station. The station is small, but it goes out all over Ghana; and if area countries have the same set up, they can pick it up. I have no idea how many have the ability to even

see that program. We were able to buy up a two-and-a-half-hour block around Christmas and preached the theme "Why Christmas." We had 4 preachers, and it was a great opportunity for us all to explain from the fall of man to the resurrection the need for Christ. I preach live on the TV every Thursday at 5pm to 5:30pm. Pray for me because opportunities to preach mean little without the power to preach them. Pray for our Sunday Bible club Deborah and Jennifer have been teaching; pray it will grow.

We have a great desire to get the gospel out in our area and as far out as we can. Almost everyone I witness to had a salvation based on works, but they don't understand Biblical salvation at all. Most believe worship and singing are as or more important than the Bible and blindly follow anything their pastor or denomination says. The fact that few read their Bibles but trust fully in their denomination is worship of a church group and not of the Lord.

Please pray with me as a young man, who is about an hour from me, asked me to train him. This is a great opportunity but I can't travel back and forth every week like I did for 2 years or so. I am trying to buy a high quality video camera that I can also record for the TV if I need to.

All of these opportunities are open to me; pray that God will help me in our village as well. I really want this church to grow. Many of the ones that are coming right now we drive to church in our van. When we go home on furlough I don't have anyone to fill in for me right now. I don't really know where I am going to get someone to fill in. There are young Bible students in the area, but I need someone with a little maturity. I also don't want to lose some of the children because there won't be anyone to bring them to church. Pray for Joseph as I will only have a year to help him get a drivers license and settled into American life. He was born in Africa and has been with me almost every day. This is going to be a hard transition for our family.
